

INVITATIONAL FREESTYLE

Friday, May 28th, 7:30pm – John Justin Arena**

The Texas Classic is an NRHA approved Invitational Freestyle competition. The event will be held during a ticketed performance in front of a large crowd on Friday, May 28th at 7:30pm in the John Justin Arena at the Will Rogers Memorial Center. The event is an excellent way to market your horses, yourself and your business to an interested audience of enthusiasts and potential customers.

If you are interested in auditioning for an invitation, please submit a video with a complete detail of your show record and description of your proposed program to: HorsePower, Inc., PO Box 8350, Denver, CO 80201. All interested parties should submit their audition for invitation no later than May 10, 2009.

The total prize money for the Challenger's Cup Freestyle Reining is \$10,000, and will be distributed according to the NRHA payback schedule with a minimum of \$200 guaranteed to every entry. (Distribution: total prize money, less \$200 per horse, then distributed according to NRHA schedule B).

All NRHA rules and regulation shall apply to the Texas Classic Freestyle Reining as will the general rules and regulation found in this premium book. Each invitee will be granted one free stall and 4 bags of shavings ONLY if they are not showing in other portions of The Classic. Horses showing in other portions of The Classic that make entry and compete in the Texas Classic Freestyle will be granted a discount of \$30 for one stall.

There is no entry fee for the Challenger's Cup Freestyle Reining. All NRHA-required memberships, fees and competition licenses shall be mandatory upon entry of the Freestyle Reining.

A short public-address biography (limited to one paragraph consisting of no more than 10 sentences) is required for each entry. Bios should feature accomplishments of the horse and/or rider or an introduction to the coming program. Bios should be delivered to the horse show office along with your selected music no later than 3:00pm on Thursday, May 27.

It is strongly recommended that music be submitted on CD (mp3 file preferred) and cued to the exact place of start for the program. Two separate copies of the music will be required to reduce risk of technical complications. The Classic has access to a production and editing company that can assist you at an economical rate in altering your music to your taste or needs, and within the NRHA time limit.

Rehearsals will be held Thursday evening after the completion of the last class. It is strongly recommended that riders use this time as a full dress rehearsal, however it is not required. The order of go for rehearsal will be posted in the show office by 4:00pm that day.

The Texas Classic Freestyle Reining will offer some amount of special effect lighting for your program. Please be prepared to communicate your needs or concerns to the production staff at the beginning of your rehearsal time.
